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I. Introducing PNU



1. Pusan National University - A Comprehensive National University

Pusan National University is a comprehensive national university founded in May 1946 as Korea's first public university under the motto of 'Truth, Liberty and Devotion.' Since then, the university has grown into a major research institution through expanding educational and research infrastructure and developing and innovating software. PNU has been dedicated to advancing and specializing its four campuses Jangjeon(Main) Campus and Ami Campus in Busan, Yangsan Campus, and Miryang Campus and is now recognized as a globally prestigious university.

As of 2021, PNU has graduated a total of 240,000 students. Currently, the university has about 30,000 students enrolled in total, about 3,200 faculty members, and about 500 university employees handling daily operations. PNU operates more than 90 majors in 16 colleges, one general graduate school, five

professional graduate schools(Law, International Studies, Medicine, Dentistry, and Korean Medicine), and eight special graduate schools(Business Administration, Public Administration, Education, Industry, Environment, Economy and International Trade, Technology Entrepreneurship, Finance). About 90 affiliated research institutes are actively involved in cuttingedge research on behalf of PNU.

This year, there are more than 1,800 international students: 600 full-time degree seeking undergraduate students, 500 students working towards a master's degree, 200 students in doctoral programs, 300 students in the Korean Language Program, and about 200 visiting and exchange students. Internationally, PNU has established academic exchange programs with over 464 colleges, universities and other institutions of higher education from 53 countries, including such distinguished partners as Oxford University(UK), Fraunhofer Institute for Manufacturing, Technology and Applied Materials Research(Germany), the University of California, Berkeley(USA), Tokyo University(Japan), and Beijing University and Tsinghua University(China). Students, researchers and faculty members at PNU and its partner institutions have been working closely together through short-term and long-term exchange programs, joint research programs, academic materials exchange and in numerous workshops, seminars and conferences.

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II. Starting at PNU



1. Orientation for International Students

- 1) Who: All newly-admitted students and exchange students (current students may attend).
- 2) When: Immediately after each semester begins.
 - lpha In order to prevent COVID19 infection, we will send group materials instead of offline briefing sessions. Please pay attention to the details for those who have confirmed their eligibility.
- **3) What:** Introduction to PNU, class registration, immigration, dormitory life, how to use campus facilities, and other important information for new students.
- 4) Languages: English, Korean and Chinese(Choose one)



2. Certification and use of facilities (Student ID/Library Access/ Certificate of Enrolment)

From November 2020, the issuance of general student ID cards (non-financial student ID cards) will be terminated. Please use the "Mobile Student Card" and "Mobile Library Pass" below.



III. Academic Management



* Note: New students must contact their departments to receive guidance on course selection before choosing courses.

1. Courses of Study

1) General Education Courses

- a. Required General Education Courses: Required courses designed to promote communicative skills, English language skills, and computers skills.
- b. Elective General Education Courses: Ideologies and History(Area 1), Society and Culture(Area 2), Literature and Arts(Area 3), Science and Technology(Area 4), Health and Recreation(Area 5), Foreign Languages(Area 6), Interdisciplinary Studies(Area 7). Must attain designated credits per each areas.

2) Major Courses

- a. Fundamental Major Courses: Required mandatory courses designed to provide basic knowledge to pursue each major/department.
- Required Major Courses: Basic courses required by each major/department for professional academic development of the major.
- c. Elective Major Courses: Courses for in-depth study of the major.

3) Elective Courses

- a. Courses offered by other majors. Students are free to choose any of the elective courses on their own excluding required general education courses or elective general education courses. If a student's major credits exceed the required credits, they will be counted as elective course credits.
- b. If a student has taken course(s) from Foreign Languages(Area 6) after earning all of the credits for elective general education courses, they will be counted as elective course credits.

4) Required Subjects for Undergraduate Foreign Students

- a. Target: At the time of admission, TOPIK level 3 or lower students
- b. Exempt target: TOPIK level 4 or higer students, Global studies studnts, Transfer students
- c. Exempt method: After the acquisiotion of TOPIK level 4 or higher the course will be exempte from the next semester

c. Completion method

- Natural sciences and engineering/Entertainment and sports: completion of 1 course
- Humanities and social sciences: completion of 2 courses
- Students can take it in the semester you want before graduating it, and you can take
 only one course per semester.

 - Take an exempt exam in our university

2. Academic Evaluation and Grading

- 1) Exams: There will be mid-term exams and final exams. Makeup exams are allowed for students who miss regular exams due to unexpected or unavoidable circumstances. However, if the student is responsible for missing exams, grading will be limited to under B+
- 2) Grades = Exam Score(Mid-term & Final) + Attendance + Term papers + Quizzes + Class Participation
- 3) Grades and Grade Points
 - Grades: A+(4.5), A0(4.0), B+(3.5), B0(3.0), C+(2.5), C0(2.0), D+(1.5), D0(1.0), F(0)

4) Academic Assessment Scales

- a. Relative Scale: Major courses, Theory courses of all general education courses.
- b. Absolute Scale: Lab classes, special development courses(open-courses, special lectures), and others.
- c. "Practical English," "Practical Computer," "Information Technology Usage," and "Job Competence Development" courses are graded as 'S'(Satisfactory) or 'U'(Unsatisfactory).
- **5) Grade Checks and Challenges**: Students may challenge their grades and ask their professors for a grade revision during the designated period for challenging and revising grades. Grades cannot be revised afterwards.
- 6) Attendance: If you miss two-thirds of the total class hours or more, you will be given an 'F' grade.

3. Class Registration and Class Withdrawal(W)

- 1) Wishing course list: A system of selecting and select courses which you want to choose. You also need to apply courses even if you finished the wishing list.
 - * Automatic application: It is only for undergraduates, and will automatically apply courses which in the wishing list. A system that can help students even if they do not apply for course. (Need to check the results of automatic application.)

2) Class Registration

- a. You are advised to select classes with the assistance of your department or division and register on the course registration page within the designated period every semester.
- b. If you fail to register for classes or pay tuition fees within the designated period, you will be expelled from the university.
 - -Go to the Student Support System(http://e-onestop.pusan.ac.kr): Click the tab 'Courses' → Click 'Class Registration' on the left sidebar 'Class Registration & Check' → Click 'Undergraduate / Graduate Course Class Registration' and select a program(Undergraduate or Graduate) → Log in → Register for classes
- * Student Support System website(http://e-onestop.pusan.ac.kr): provides course registration services, printout of the final schedule, tuition payment check, and grade check. It is highly recommended to visit this website on a regular basis to receive updated information.

- b. Register courses by curriculum with instructions by the department.
- c. Students are responsible for their own class registration and having a copy of their final schedule after completing class registration(click 'Class Schedule' Print out)
- d. Second Course Re-Registration is available to students who have registered for classes that are to be eliminated.

3) Class Withdrawal(W)

a. You may withdraw from up to two(2) classes each semester. For undergraduate student:

Make sure that your remaining credits after the withdrawal are 12 or more. Students who are in their 7th semester or thereafter must have at least one credit after the withdrawal.

- * For graduate students must remaining 3 credits, but for the School of Law, students must remaining 9 credits.
- b. Withdrawn classes will not appear on your academic transcript nor be counted towards grading, credits earned, or GPA calculation.
- c. http://e-onestop.pusan.ac.kr → Courses → Class withdrawal → Web application for regularsemester/vacation session → Choose subject for withdrawal, input contact info and the reason for withdrawal → click 'Application for Withdrawal' → click 'Delete' after choosing subject for withdrawal → Class have your final schedule after withdrawal(click 'class schedule' Print out)
- * For graduate students: Print out the application form after apply → get a sign from faculty advisor → submit at the department office
- d. Withdrawal period: during April / October

4. Double Majors and Minors

- 1) Available Departments: Colleges of Humanities, Social Sciences, Natural Sciences, Engineering(excluding Architecture Department and the study of architecture in the Department of Urban, Architecture and Civil Engineering), Education, Business, Economics and International Business, Human Ecology, Arts, Department of Art, Culture and Image, College of Nano Science
- 2) Targets: Undergraduate students completing credit for the second year

- 3) Application Period: Will be notified in mid-June and mid-December every year. Students can apply in designated application period.
- **4) Completion of Double Major:** Students must complete the minimum number of major courses(to include 'Fundamental' major courses, 'Mandatory' courses, and 'General Elective' courses) required by the department where they wish to double major.

5) Minors

- a. Minoring involves completing a certain number of courses of other majors in a systematic order.
- b. Application Period for a Minor: Students may apply for a minor from the first semester in their second year.
- c. Completion of Minor: Students must earn a minimum of 21 credits from the major courses specified in the curriculum of the department in which they wish to minor, including nine(9) credits in basic major courses and designated required courses.
- d. Students are not permitted to minor in the College of Pharmacy, the College of Medicine, the College of Dentistry, the College of Nursing, the College of Arts(except the Department of Art, Culture and Image, the Department of Architecture, and the Department of Global Studies), and the study of architecture in the Department of Urban, Architecture and Civil Engineering in the College of Technology.
- e. How to Apply: Students must submit an application approved by the chair of the department of their major and minor to their major department office.

5. Summer/Winter Sessions

- Summer and winter sessions are operated for currently enrolled students during vacation months, respectively.
- 2) Eligible students:
 - a. Students currently enrolled at PNU during the summer/winter session enrollment dates;
 - b. Students who have gotten approval for re-enrollment for summer/winter session;
 - c. Students who have been recommended by the dean of a home university with an agreement contract with PNU.
- 3) Maximum number of credits: six(6) credits or less.

6. Leave of Absence and Re-enrollment

- 1) Leave of Absence (Must leave the country within 30 days)
 - a. Students who are in the undergraduate course, Department of Medicine at the professional Graduate School of Medicine(Graduates, Integrated MD·PhD), the Professional Graduate School of Dentistry(Graduates, Integrated MD·PhD) and the Professional Graduate School of Korean Medicine(Graduates, Integrated MD·PhD), and the professional Graduate School of Law, undergraduate freshmen (Integrated Bachelor and Master's) are NOT able to take a leave of absence in their first semester.
 - The duration of a leave of absence differs by degree. (However, exceptions can be made for military service, illness, pregnancy, childbirth, child care, venture, study abroad for over one(1) year, language course study, and others.)
 - Those who have gotten the approval for a leave of absence are required to visit the International Student Center(ISC) and the Busan Immigration Office immediately to obtain a 30-day preparation visa. The previous visa will expire and it is highly recommended to exit within 30 days.
- 2) Re-enrollment: After the leave of absence ends, or during the leave of absence if students want to re-enroll, they must submit a re-enrollment application to their department and get approval. Students may pay for tuition afterwards. For students who want to re-enroll, they should apply for a certification of admission letter to visa@pusan.ac.kr when they apply for admission.

7. Academic Probation

- 1) You will be placed on academic probation if your GPA falls below 1.80.
- If you are on academic probation, you are required to register for three(3) credits less than normally allowed in the subsequent semester.
- 3) If you are on academic probation for two consecutive semester, you are required to take 'Hyowon Academic Consulting.' If you fail to attend, you can only register for under 10 credits.
- If you are on academic probation for three consecutive semesters, you will be expelledfrom the university.
- If you are admitted through re-admission, previous academic probations will not be counted as part of any future academic probation.

6) International students on academic probation will have to apply for 'Academic Probation Counseling' managed by the ISC to counselling@pusan.ac.kr(you will be notified individually by email).

8. Expulsion

Students should exit Korea within 30 days

- 1) Students who fail to re-enroll without a justifiable reason after their leave of absence.
- 2) Students who are enrolled in other academic institutions.
- 3) Students who are considered unable to continue their studies due to serious illness.
- 4) Students who fail to pay enrollment fees or register for classes during the designated period.
- 5) Students on academic probation for three consecutive semesters.
- 6) Students who exceed the maximum number of semesters of enrollment.
- 7) Students who decide to drop out.

9. Graduation

Students who have graduated should exit Korea within 30 days or change one's visa

1) Regular Graduation

- a. Students must complete required courses and earn required credits for graduation within the maximum number of semesters of enrollment.
- b. Students must maintain a GPA of 2.0 or higher for the total number of semesters of their studies.
- c. Students must fulfill graduation requirements(graduation thesis, exams, others) designated by each department.

- a. Early graduation is defined as granting a degree without enrollment for the 8th semester to students who have fulfilled their graduation requirements by taking special exams for earning credits, earning extra credits each semester, and/or earning credits during summer/winter sessions.
- b. Eligibility: Students who have fulfilled their graduation requirements by the sixth or seventh semesters and have a GPA of 4.0 or higher for the total semesters of their studies.
- c. Transfer students, readmitted students, and students on academic probation are not eligible for early graduation.

10. Student Exchange Programs and Credit Transfer

Student Exchange Programs: Studying at a Korean or overseas university with which PNU has an academic exchange agreement.

- 1) Eligible Students: Currently enrolled students approved by the university president upon recommendation by the dean of their college. In the case of a study abroad program, students who are selected as successful candidates for such a program.
- 2) Duration of Student Exchange: Within 1/2 of the required number of regular semesters; no such restrictions for summer and winter sessions.
- **3) Transferable Credits:** Within 1/2 of the required number of credits for graduation or course completion, including the credits earned in summer or winter sessions.
- 4) Credit Transfer: Submit application form to department office → deliberation by department faculty committee → submit to department administration office → approval by academic office

- Submission of the relevant certificate should be done within the designated period
 according to notice by PNU International.
- c. Selection Method: Selection based on score
- d. Payment: Scholarship amount will be credited towards the total amount of tuition and will be recognized in the tuition bill.

- 3) Teaching and Research Assistant Scholarships

- a. Qualifications: Students who are enrolled in the general graduate school (enrolled students with a GPA of 3.0 or higher in the previous semester / freshmen have no limit based on GPA).
- b. Work Period: five(5) months every semester
- c. Required Work Hours and Scholarship
- Teaching assistant: 230 hours for one semester; Tuition I (including entrance fee) + a portion of Tuition II (KRW1,500,000)
- Research assistant: 170 hours for one semester; tuition fee I (including entrance fee) + a portion of tuition fee II ((KRW1,000,000))
- d. How to Apply: Check the notices from each department and submit the application form during the designated period.

3. Ineligibility

- 1) Students who are below the required GPA 2.5 score.
- Students who received any type of academic disciplinary measures from the university in the previous semester.
- 3) Students who enrolled in an extra semester beyond the maximum number of semesters in which courses may be taken.
- 4) Students who failed to obtain minimum completion credits(12 credits) per semester(except students who completed over seven semesters).
- 5) Students who are disqualified for other accepted reasons

4. Loss of Scholarship Qualification and Cancellation

- 1) Students who qualify due to one of the issues below may have their scholarship cancelled.
 - · Students selected for scholarship who are placed on probation before the semester begins, take a leave of absence, or drop out.
 - · Students selected for scholarship who are placed on probation after the semester begins, takes a leave of absence, or drops out.
- 2) If cancellation of scholarship occurs after registering for the semester, it will be retroactively rescinded and tuition will be charged and should be paid immediately.

5. Overlapping Scholarship Regulations and Exceptions

- 1) Scholarships will not be given exceeding the amount of tuition for the semester.
- However, exceptions will be made for cases in which the student may receive overlapping scholarships.
 - \cdot Scholarship is given when it is irrelevant to tuition, such as exchange student living expenses or other reasons.
 - · Scholarship is given when it is an additional payment irrelevant to tuition for dormitory, meals, and daily expenses.
 - · Financial reward from competition prizes.
 - · Payment from engagement in official work.
 - · If the amount of the scholarship exceeding tuition is below 1/2 of the class fee.
 - · For other reasons acknowledged by the dean of the college.





- Scholarship certificates can only be given to one student during the advisor's warranty period (a certificate of employment and identification of an advisor is required to submit)

ii. Undergraduate(D-2-2) → Master(D-2-3) Master(D-2-3) → Doctorate(D-2-4)

Change of visa type within D-2(Study Abroad) is considered extending period of stay of visa, so you should submit extension documents(you can apply 4 months before expiration date).

 - Only accepted in cash*. GKS students are exempted from paying fee of KRW 60.000.

- (§) Financial certificate (finished the front degree at PNU: 10 million Korean won/ from other school: 20 million Korean won)
 - Bank balance certificate under students name (the bankbook issued in Korea), scholarship certificate, etc. Amount issued must be within 30 days of the application date.
 - Scholarship certificates can only be given to one student during the advisor's warranty period (a certificate of employment and identification of an advisor is required to submit)
 - Bank statement (recent one-year inquiry) corresponds to the receipt of labor expenses from an advisor while studying, and the deposit amount must be at least KRW 800,000 per month (part-time employment permit for study-related activities).

- Documented proof of residence*: Contract of housing rental, mail of visa date expiration, receipt of dormitory fee payment, or other proof
- ③ **Financial Proof**: Bank balance statement over KRW 10,000,000 (extension for one year), over KRW 5,000,000 (extension for 6 months)
- * If previous semester's GPA is above 2.0, it can be exempted.
- The issue date for certificate of bank balance must be within 30 days after the reporting date.
- Certificate of Balance: Only certificate of balance issued by a bank in Korea (overseas documents are not accepted)
- Students who receive scholarships (tuition and living expenses) can submit scholarship certificates instead (scholarships can only be given to one student per advisor during the warranty period, and additional certificates of employment and identification card are required to submit)
- Bank statement: Submit a deposit amount within last year if there is a history of receiving labor cost.
- Submit when the labor cost 1 million won were paid every month, and the deposit amount must be made within last year.
- Participation in research related to academic studies through in-school research activities is exempted from part-time work permits, a certificate of guidance professor and a recommendation letter of department president are required to submit.
- Tuberculosis result: same as "4. How to change status of Residency 4) required documents i. Language Study (D-4) -> Study Abroad (D-2) 3Tuberculosis result"
- (§) Researchers who have completed study: Documents mentioned above and financial proof are mandatory, additional submission of explanation document confirmed by professor/certificate for course completion.
- ※ Period of permission for extension of staying after completion of study: Master(3 years), Ph.D(5 years) ※ When submitting Certificate of scholarship, specify participation in the thesis-related project
- **® Undergraduate and graduate students who exceed term of study:** For undergraduates, 4 years (8 semesters); for graduates, 2 years (4 semesters). Students who exceed their terms of study, submit the documents (1), (2) mentioned above and financial proof, additional submission of explanation document confirmed by professor/ advisor and statement of reasons (only for undergraduates).
- Students who finish course but have not yet completed thesis need to apply for extension of credits and thesis preparation seperately.

6. How to Issue Alien Registration Cards

- 2) Application Period: Within 90 days from the date of entry to Korea(within two weeks after semester begins)

8. How to Report Visa Information Changes

1) Information Changes

- Residence address
- Name, Gender, Date of Birth, Nationality
- Passport Facts: Passport number, passport issuing date, expiry date.
- Name change of university, institution(ex. after language study, entering an undergraduate program, or entering PNU after graduating or give up from another university).
- 2) Application Period: Within 14 days from the information changing
- 3) How to Apply: Visit Busan Immigration Office or Geumjeong Gu City Hall or apply at the Immigration Office website(www.hikorea.go.kr)
- **4) Application Documents:** Alien registration change application, passport, alien registration card and etc.
 - If you drop out and start a new course as a same degree, you must obtain a D2 visa from overseas missions after leaving Korea.

9. Return of Alien Registration Card

1) When to Return

- Leave of Absence: Return at airport on departure(re-issued at Busan Immigration Office when re-enrolling).
- Graduation: Return at airport on departure or to Busan Immigration Office before departure.
- Exchange & Visiting Students: Return at airport on departure
- Changing to Korea Nationality: Return to Busan Immigration Office within 14 days of acquiring Korean nationality.
- 2) If you do not return within the period designated, there will be penalties.
 - ** When acquiring Korean citizenship, visit the ISC within three days after acquiring the nationality and carry the ARC or ID card.

- a. Manufacturing industry stated on business license(since 2017. 9. 1.)
- b. Construction industry stated on business license(since 2018. 11. 1.)
- c. Students whose attendance rate is less than 70% or with a GPA of 2.0 or less in recent semester are restricted.
- 8) Exception of permission:
 - a. International students who receive pay from internship course related to credit or research project
 - → Internship related to credit and compulsory course do not need extra permission to receive pay.
 - Corporate internship before graduation is not permitted neither considered as parttime employment.
 - → Students receive pay from research project related to course credit at school do not need extra permission. Personal project unrelated to study is considered as part-time employment if it is conducted at school, but it is not permitted to work in other institution.

10. Departure after Leave of Absence/Expulsion/Permanent Leave

- ** According to Article 19 of the "Immigration Control Law," when a student is reported to the Korean Ministry of Justice for taking a "Leave of Absence," or expulsion, or permanent leave, his or her visa is cancelled. The student should leave the country within 30 days; if staying in the country without other relatives or a valid visa, the student will be classified as an illegal alien and can incur penalties from the Ministry of Justice.
- ► This is the guide for departing or staying in Korea <u>from the date a leave of absence has been approved</u> depending on whether the remaining days in your visa are:
- 1) within 30 days; 2) more than 30 days; or 3) when you are overseas.
- 1) Remaining period of stay is within 30 days: depart before the expiration date.
- 2) Remaining period of stay is over 30 days: Busan Immigration Office will issue 'Attendance Request' to the student via mail → individually visit the immigration office to discuss your departure date.
 - Attendee(visited immigration office): after giving the student a chance to explain about his or her change in academic status, if immigration does not deem the reasons appropriate for further stay in Korea(according to Article 89 of the Immigration Code) from the date of the change in academic status or the day the student visited the office, he or she will be ordered to leave within 30 days
 - Non-Attendee(did not visit immigration office): An 'Attendance Request' notice will be publicly posted according to 'Article 92, Clause ② ⇒ Residence is Cancelled' of the Immigration Code and the student who did not report to immigration will be declared missing 14 days after publication.
- 3) Students who are overseas after a Leave of Absence/Withdrawal/Expulsion is confirmed will be reported to the Ministry of Justice and will lose their D-2 visa and will be denied entry into Korea.

11. S-3(Part-time Employment) Visa

- 1) Who: Part-time job seekers among D-2 visa holders(only allowed if GPA is over 2.0)
- 2) Application Period: One(1) week before employment starts
- 3) How to Apply
 - a. Part-time employment application(students, employers)
 - b. Part-time employment application approval(visit ISC)
- c. Visit Busan Immigration Office or apply at the Immigration Office website (http://www.hikorea.go.kr)
- 4) Required Documents: Passport, alien registration card, part-time employment application, business registration certificate of the employer(copy), transcript, TOPIK transcript, employment contract
- 5) Limits on Work Hours:
 - a. Undergraduate: 20 hours/week (IEQAS Universities: 25 hours/week)
 - b. Master's, doctoral degree students, master's diploma and Ph.D. candidates: 30 hours/

12. Employment (D-10)

- 1) Scope of Job: (job engagement) Not only includes looking for work at domestic firms and organizations but also short-term internships before getting formal employment.
- 2) Limit of the 1 time staying: 6months
- 3) Who and Requirements
 - a. Education Background and Job Wanted Area: A foreigner with a bachelor's degree (including a domestic professional) or higher, seeking a job in an E-1~E-7 area.
 - b. Grades Requirements: According to the calculation table of the scores of employment activities in the annex, those with a total score of more than 20 for basic items and a total score of more than 60 out of the total score of 190.
 - c. Major and Type of Occupation: A visa is allowed to be issued when having the qualification conditions and the occupation to be employed belongs to the professional field and the professional type of the licensed object.

4) Who was Limited

- a. Offender: The application restriction is limited if the total amount of money ordered to leave the country within a year or the total amount ordered to return to Korea at their own expense or the total amount imposed on notices or fines exceeds 2 million won.
- The qualification for a job with a score system is excluded from the application if there is a history of employment and related immigration law violations, such as illegal employment, non-qualification activities, and part-time employment violations while staying in Korea.
- **b. prevention of Institutional Abuse**: In order to prevent the disorder of detention caused by blind visa application, visa issuance is restricted in principle in the following cases.
- Stay for more than 6 months with D-10 qualification in the latest year
- * However, at the invitation of domestic enterprises, groups, etc., when conducting research as interns, visa issue admitted for only once time, and the D-10 qualification for internship purposes can not be detained for more than one year at most.
- 5) Application Tips: As soon as identity changes (including scheduled), apply to the competent office of residence, etc.

6) Screening Criteria

* Study abroad (D-2) Qualified means a person who is scheduled to graduate with the requirement to change to a job (D-10) qualification(However, if you have a bachelor's degree or higher from a university in your country or a third country and have the necessary career requirements, you can change it even if you are in school.)

[Detailed evaluation and scoring table of the score-based work visa (D-10-1)]

- Score requirement: Who scores more than 20 out of 190 points or more in total score more than 60 points.
- ※ However, if a person has been fined more than 400,000 won for violating the Immigration Control Act related to employment, such as illegal employment and part-time employment, exclude from the application.
- a. Basic items: those with a score of 20 or higher out of maximum 50 points

- Additional points for science and engineering among those with a degree in Korean professional studies are also awarded.
- ** Foreign experts in science and engineering fields are excluded because they cannot be examined for academic background.

5) Who have experience in high-income professional: 5 points

- Additional points are given to foreigners with annual salary of \$50,000 or more, if confirmed through the government-issued income statement of the country concerned.



X. Life in Korea



1. Introducing Korea

South Korea, officially the Republic of Korea, is a democratic nation located on the southern half of the Korean Peninsula in East Asia. China is to the northwest, Japan to the east across the Korea Strait. The capital of Korea is Seoul. Following years of devastation, Korea has achieved rapid economic growth since the Korean War and is often referred to as the "Miracle on the Han River."

As of 2018, Korea was the 11th largest economy worldwide in terms of real GDP. People in South Korea call themselves "Han-guk(한국)," short for "Dae-han-min-guk(대한민국)." Korea has a population of 51,780,579 and a total land area of 99,720 km (as of 2021.01).

2. Introduction to Busan

1) Location

Busan is located on the southeastern tip of the Korean Peninsula. The city is situated within South Gyeongsang Province and faces the Korea Strait to the south. It borders the cities of Ulsan and Yangsan to the north and Gimhae to the west. Among the cities located on a similar latitude to Busan are: Tokyo in Japan, Zhengzhou in China, Algiers in Algeria, and Oklahoma City in the US. Busan shares a similar longitude with Verkhoyansk in Siberia, Nagasaki in Japan and Darwin in Australia.



2) History

Busan managed to make rapid and impressive strides since the port of Busan became an international port in 1876. 1905 marks the year that the Gyeongbu Railway Line was built, prompting the construction of piers and harbors in Busan. The city grew rapidly after the capital of the provincial government of Gyeongnam Province was moved to Busan in 1925. In 1950, the city also served as a temporary capital of Korea, running overall operations of the country during the Korean War. In 1963, Busan became a directly-governed city(Jikhalshi), leading the economic development of Korea up through the 1970s. The city was elevated to Busan Metropolitan City(Gwangyeokshi) in 1995 along with the expansion of the municipal area. Busan is Korea's leading port and a world-class city of culture and tourism that hosts a wide variety of events and festivals, such as the Busan International Film Festival(BIFF) and the Busan Fireworks Festival in Gwangali Beach. Finally, whether 'Busan' or 'Pusan,' it is the same amazing city. For many years in the past, Busan was spelled with a 'P' and that is why PNU—with its rich history and tradition—continues to use this older reference.

3) Facts

- Size: 769.89 km (0.8% of national territory)
- Administrative divisions: 15 districts(구: gu), 1 county(군: goon), and 216 sub-districts(동: dong)
- Population: about 3,360,000 (2021.06)

4) Climate

Busan boasts a temperate climate with four distinct seasons, since it is located on the southeastern tip of the Korean Peninsula to the east of the Eurasia continent and under the constant influence of East Asia's periodic wind currents. The city's yearly average temperature is 15°C, with an annual precipitation of 1,176 mm. Busan has relatively strong winds compared to other regions of Korea.

3. Holidays

1) Samiljeol(Independence Movement Day: March 1)

 The day commemorating Korea's independence movement that started on March 1,1919 and spread throughout the country with displays of resistance during the occupation of the Korean Empire by Japan.

2) Children's Day(May 5)

• The anniversary established to cherish children and to promote the happiness of children.

3) Buddha's Birthday(May 12)

• The day when the Buddha was born.

4) Memorial Day(June 6)

• The day commemorating those who sacrificed their lives for the country, including people killed during the Korean War.

5) Independence Day(August 15)

• The day when Korea became independent of occupation by Japan in 1945.

6) Chuseok(September 12 ~ 15)

• A major harvest festival to celebrate the good harvest and share a feast of Korean traditional foods.

7) National Foundation Day(October 3)

• National Foundation Day is the date commemorating the opening of the country by Dangun, the progenitor of Korea.

8) Hangeul Proclamation Day(October 9)

• The day to celebrate the invention of Hangeul (Korea's alphabet).

9) Christmas Day(December 25)

• Christian holiday celebrating the birth of Jesus.

10) New Year's Day/Korean New Year's (January. 24 ~ 27)

• The biggest holiday in Korea, when all family members gather together and greet the new year.

4. Public Transportation System

1) Public Transportation Card

- a. It is convenient to use a transportation card when you take public transportation in Korea's larger cities. You can use public buses, local shuttle buses, and the subway with one card and get a discount. Discounts are not available if you pay in cash.
- b. Public transportation cards can be purchased at subway stations, Busan Bank offices, convenience stores, and corner stores near bus stops. The price for the card ranges from ₩2,000 to ₩6,000, and you can add money onto your card as needed.
- c. Transfer discounts are also available when using a public transportation card.
- d. Public Transportation Transfer Discount System
- Transfer: To change means of public transportation(city buses, the subway, or local shuttle buses), take a different subway line or different bus.
- Public Transportation Transfer Discount System: To get discounts when transferring:
- Transfer Discount: City Bus ↔ Subway ↔ Village/Neighborhood Bus
- How to Transfer: Up to two(2) transfers are permitted, each if within 30 minutes from the time you get off from the previous means of transportation.
- Application of Fares: The highest fare among the various means of transportation used during your journey will be applied as the basic fare.

2) Local City Buses

Bus fares can be paid in cash or with a public transportation card upon boarding the bus. Discounts will apply when using the card.

4) Metro(Subway)

- a. There are four main fully operational subway lines: one line running north-south(Line 1) and another that goes east-west(Line 2), as well as two complementary lines providing additional support(Lines 3 and 4). Also, East-sea line and Pusan-Gimhae metro is on operation.
- b. A ticket for one zone is KRW 1,400; Two Zones KRW 1,600
- c. Tickets can be purchased using machines inside subway stations. When using the public transportation card, a 10% discount will apply and transfer will be available.

5) Taxis

- a. Type: Regular taxis, call taxi, and jumbo taxis.
- b. Regular Taxis: You may catch this type of taxi at a taxi stand or flag one down in the street. If the taxi is vacant, you will find a "Vacant" or "For Hire" sign in red and the lamp of the taxi sign on top will be turned on. The basic fare is KRW 3,300 for the first two(2) kilometers and then additional charges are added depending on the distance and time covered. From midnight, a late-hour premium will also be charged.
- c. Call Taxis: You can use call taxis(regular or deluxe) by making a call to come to your place without additional charge.
- Deungdae call: This is a kind of call taxi and brand taxi. It is possible to use a credit card and get translation services(English, Chinese, Japanese, and Russian).
- Translation service time available: 24 hours(including Saturdays and Sundays)
- Deungdae call(051-600-1000), Tourism Association(without area code 1330 for translation service).
- d. Jumbo Taxis: Jumbo taxis are black with a yellow taxi sign on top. These are large passenger vehicles that can accommodate as many as 5 to 10 passengers. When you have many

passengers or a lot of baggage, this type of taxi will be more convenient for your group. The fare system is the same as the deluxe taxis(KRW 5,000 for the first 3 kilometers and additional charges will be imposed depending on the distance and time covered).

6) Express Buses & Intercity Buses

- a. Recommended for long-distance travel out of Busan
- b. Seobu Bus Terminal and Busan Bus Terminal are connected to subway stations

7) Railways & Trains

- a. Tickets: Busan Station and Gupo Station
- b. Express Trains(KTX): The Super High-speed KTX connects major Korean cities including Seoul, Daejeon, Daegu and Busan. Fares differ based on the distance you travel.
- c. Regular Trains: Saemaul train, Mugungwha train


3) By Metro(Subway)




